Will has dabbled in other artistic mediums including painting and more recently video. Last year his documentary film work was acclaimed in state AP competition.



Will has experience with several forms of photo essays and will demonstrate some of his award winning work. Even if you don't contemplate doing a photo essay this should be an inspiring evening.

I am fascinated with abstracts and the indirectly perceived. I also paint in pastels and oils. I have enjoyed both wet and digital darkroom work.






